

Driving and Student Drop-off at Lawrence School

This letter explains important driving and drop-off procedures for students at Lawrence School. We urge all families who can do so to walk to Lawrence School in the morning. If you need to use a car to deliver your child, it is very important that you read this information carefully. Parking maps are posted outside the office and available in the office.

DRIVE-THRU / DROP-OFF

- The school curbside drop-off zone is in front of school on Francis Street. NO STANDING OR PARKING.
- Students should exit cars in front of the school in the designated area only, and cars should move on as quickly as possible. There is a crossing guard in front of school who will enforce the no-standing/parking rules.
- ***Drop-off and pick-up of students behind Lawrence or on Newell Road is PROHIBITED.*** The new driveway is intended for trash pick-up and deliveries only and is not designed for cars to turn around in. See other 'NO PARKING AREAS' below.
- Please access Francis Street from Kent Street for drop-off to keep traffic flowing past the school on Francis Street.

PARKING TO WALK A CHILD INTO SCHOOL

2-hour parking is available on:

- Longwood Avenue
- Perry Street
- A small block of spaces west of the school on Francis

Legal parking up until 8:30am is available on:

- Kent Square (running between Kent and Harrison Streets)
- Toxteth Street
- Cars still on these streets after 8:30 a.m. will be ticketed.

HANDICAPPED PARKING

A new handicapped spot has been located in front of the school on Francis St.

NO PARKING AREAS

Parking and drop-off is prohibited on:

- Newell Road & Rear of School

Parking is prohibited after 8 a.m. on:

- Harrison Street
- Stearns Road
- Both ends of Francis Street.

These streets SHOULD NOT BE USED for student drop-off or parent short-term parking.

Parking for Meetings or Staying for Volunteer Work

Temporary placards and directions to unused teacher parking can be obtained from the school office ***if you are volunteering and will be at school for more than 2 hours.*** Otherwise, please use a two-hour spot. A temporary permit/placard will allow you to park in a staff permit-parking zone between 6 a.m. and 4 p.m. ***Please request a placard only if you are volunteering and will be at school for over two hours.***
