



In August 2015, a bomb completely destroyed Sarah's family home in Damascus, Syria, forcing Sarah and her sister to undertake a harrowing 30 day journey to Berlin by boat, car, train and foot. During their crossing to Greece in a small boat with other refugees, the engine died and Sarah and her sister, both professional swimmers, jumped out and pushed the boat for three and a half hours to safety on the Greek island of Lesbos. She is now working as a volunteer rescuer on Lesbos.
